NEW MEXICO RENEWABLE ENERGY TRANSMISSION AUTHORITY
INITIAL NOTICE

The New Mexico Renewable Energy Transmission Authority is contemplating entering into a project with Lucky Corridor, LLC (the “Company”) to develop, construct, operate and maintain the Company’s Mora Line transmission project (the “Mora Line”). The Mora Line is 110 miles of new transmission facilities built to connect Union County and northeastern New Mexico’s wind and solar resource region to PNM’s system at Las Vegas, New Mexico. The Mora Line will be operated at 115kV. The Mora Line will pass through Union, Colfax, Mora, and San Miguel Counties. The Mora Line will cause new substations to be built in both Union and Colfax Counties. The Mora Line is an eligible facility because the anchor customer of the Mora Line is Gallegos Wind Farm, LLC, which will generate the electricity from its 180MW Don Carlos I Wind Energy Project in Union County. The target in-service date for the Mora Line and the wind farm is September 30, 2021.

This notice constitutes compliance with NMSA 1978 62-16A-4(C)(1).
